



PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257

DIVERSION OF WINTHORPE FOOTPATH NO.3 ORDER 2026

This order is made by Newark and Sherwood District Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: *23/02881/OUTM EMW*.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the schedule to this order ("the schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Newark and Sherwood District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Newark and Sherwood District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with
4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing path or way

That part of Winthorpe Footpath No.3 shown on the attached plan commencing from a point marked A, SK 8229 5604, and proceeding for a distance of approximately 621 metres in a northly and then north westerly direction to a point marked B, SK 8170 5616, and having a width of approximately 1 metre.

PART 2

Description of site of alternative highway

The effect of the diversion is to provide a new section of unsurfaced and unobstructed path with a width of 1 meter from a point marked A, SK 8229 5604, and proceeding in a generally westerly, north westerly and finally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 799 metres to a point marked B, SK 8170 5616.
