THE FUTURE OF THE YORKE DRIVE ESTATE

Newark and Sherwood District Council has secured Government funding to look at options for regeneration of the Yorke Drive Estate. This will include considering options for development of new homes on part of the Lincoln Road Playing Fields as well as the improvement of recreation and sporting facilities on the playing fields.

In the coming months we plan to carry out a consultation and master-planning exercise that will look at all the possible options, and give local residents the opportunity to say what they think should be done. By summer 2018, the Council will draw up firm proposals to take the project forward. However, we stress that no decisions have yet been taken on this.

Everyone who lives, works or is active on the Yorke Drive Estate will have the opportunity to get involved. We have appointed regeneration experts Campbell Tickell to work with staff from the Council and Newark and Sherwood Homes to carry out a consultation exercise that will provide you with the chance to be involved in working with us to draw up improvement proposals. This will involve door to door contact, workshops, meetings, newsletters and public exhibitions.

We want to better understand the needs of the local community and your views on priorities for the area, and will be carrying out a **household survey of residents between 9th February and 2nd March** when our staff will be visiting each home to complete the survey.

Alternatively, if you would prefer, you can attend one of the survey drop in sessions arranged at the Bridge or Beaumont Walk Community Centre, details are overleaf.
